Andreas Utermann is Chief Executive Officer (CEO), Global Chief Investment Officer (CIO) and co-head of Allianz Global Investors, a global asset manager 100% owned by Allianz.

Andreas joined AllianzGI and its Global Executive Committee in 2002 as Global CIO Equities. Between his joining and the end of 2011, he was also Global CIO and Co-Head of RCM. Since 2012, Andreas has been Global CIO and co-head of AllianzGI. He re-joined the Board of Allianz Asset Management AG, the global asset management holding company of Allianz's asset management businesses in January 2016, having previously served on the Board from 2002 to 2011. In March 2016, Andreas took on the additional role of CEO.

Prior to joining AllianzGI, Andreas worked for 12 years at Merrill Lynch Investment Managers (formerly Mercury Asset Management), where he was the Global Head and CIO, Equities. Andreas also worked for two years at Deutsche Bank AG.

Andreas holds a number of non-Executive positions in the industry including Board Membership of the AMIC Council of ICMA, of which he became Vice Chair in January 2016. He has been a Member of the Board of the CFA Society of the UK since November 2011.

Andreas also supports a number of charitable causes and is a Trustee of the Utermann Charitable Trust, which has a focus on addressing environmental concerns as well as furthering education.

Andreas holds a BSc in Economics from the London School of Economics and an MA in Economics from Katholieke Universiteit Leuven. Andreas is an Associate of CFA Society of the UK (formerly the Institute of Investment Management and Research).
